Eight years after it opened in December 1895, the Grand Opera House was re-launched as The Palace of Varieties – to leave no doubt that it presented all the popular forms of entertainment of its day – musical spectaculars, melodramas, balletic extravaganzas, vaudeville, and the circus.

To move with the times the shows may have changed, but the principle hasn't: browse this brochure and you'll discover the very best in theatrical entertainment.

The brochure's cover with the sassy West End hit *Mean Girls* introduces a host of musicals very much of today, amongst them *Miss Saigon*, *Priscilla Queen of the Desert*, *The Bodyguard* and *Here and Now - The Steps Musical*. There is more musical theatre as our much-loved local musical societies stage *The Witches of Eastwick* (St Agnes' Choral Society) and *Guys and Dolls* (Belfast Operatic Company). And already on sale is our 2026 Summer Youth Production of *Chitty Chitty Bang Bang* – like the sensational sell-out *Grease* (July 2025), a showcase unrivalled in scale by any other local venue for the stellar young talent in our midst.

Irresistible Russell 'The Voice' Watson and West End, Broadway and Belfast leading lady Rachel Tucker join master illusionist Derren Brown in a line-up of dazzling new shows each magnificently showcasing the distinctive talents of its star. There is distinguished drama in Harper Lee's ever-popular heart-rending *To Kill a Mockingbird* and in a very different but equally thrilling classic: Agatha Christie's *Death on the Nile*. The multi-talented Caroline Curran, as both writer of and performer in her joyous Christmas comedy *Deck the Hols* in The Studio,

returns to the main stage in February as Maggie Muff in *Maggie's Menopause*, an uninhibited new comedy by Leesa Harker.

The Barber of Seville is opera at its most sunny and hilarious, with its merry tunes and droll characters, and in February we are delighted to be partnering with the excellent Lyric Opera Ireland in this sparkling production with full orchestra.

130 years ago, it was pantomime that opened Belfast's new Grand Opera House. For our 130th birthday, this December, we have a new pantomime title: *The Adventures of Pinocchio* – overflowing as ever with laughter, spectacle, thrilling song and dance and wonderful special effects undreamed of by our ancestors in 1895. It's selling extremely fast – so make sure your nearest and dearest enjoy an unforgettable theatrical Christmas – book without delay!

In 1909 they had to drop the name The Palace of Varieties because audiences had already taken the Grand Opera House to their hearts. Happily, some things don't change.
